

Tecumseh Athletic Boosters Soccer College Scholarships

The Tecumseh Athletic Boosters Soccer College Scholarships are intended to recognize a senior male and a senior female Tecumseh High School (THS) graduating varsity soccer player who have displayed exemplary sportsmanship while maintaining a high standard of outstanding athletic achievement.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible, a scholarship applicant shall:

- be a graduating male or female THS senior; <u>or</u> a male or female senior whose legal residence is located within the Tecumseh Local School District and enrolled in and graduating from: 1) <u>Springfield-Clark Career Technology Center</u>; <u>or</u> 2) <u>Dayton Regional STEM School</u>; <u>or</u> 3) <u>Springfield Global Impact STEM Academy</u>; <u>or</u> 4) an approved program of home-education with eligibility to participate in THS athletics in accordance with the <u>Ohio Revised Code</u> and/or applicable bylaws of the Ohio High School Athletic Association; <u>and</u>
- hold a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher; and
- earned at least two THS varsity letters in the sport of soccer, to include a letter in the applicant's senior year; *and*
- submit along with their application a typed or printed essay of not less than 100 words on the theme, "The positive role high school soccer has played in my life;" and
- have exemplary citizenship (i.e. student-athlete role model); and
- have shown exemplary sportsmanship (i.e. ethics and integrity); and
- have applied to an institution of higher education.

Selection:

The final selection of winners will be determined by a committee consisting of the THS athletic director, one THS administrator, two THS coaches and one THS Athletic Boosters member.

Award:

A one-time, nonrenewable stipend of at least \$1,500 will be awarded to one male and one female winner.

Deadline:

Submit all required documents to the THS Athletic Office not later than March 31st of the applicant's graduation year.

Payment:

A check will be issued to scholarship recipients after a copy of the paid first quarter or first semester bill from the athlete's chosen institution of higher education is provided to the THS athletic director.
